

YOUR GUIDE TO STAYING INFORMED

With so much constantly changing in the Primary Healthcare sector, it can be hard keeping up with the constant change.

However, whilst hard, it is critical that your practice is prepared and ready to action any changes that may impact your business and/or patients.

Changes that may be relevant to your practice and should be managed include:

- **Government initiatives, such as changes to the MBS or new programs such as MyMedicare.
- Mortant legislative changes, such as prescribing requirements or upcoming changes to the Assignment of Benefit workflow.
- Software changes, including any important issues your Practice may need to be aware of, new features your practice should take advantage of or changes in pricing/subscription fees.
- Compliance requirements, such as changes to accreditation or other practice related compliance matters, financial or contractual obligations.

So how do you stay informed?

Firstly, it is critical that your practice nominates staff members who are responsible for monitoring and implementing key change. This can be assigned to a single staff member or multiple, depending on the role/s they play within your organisation.

For example, you may wish to assign a clinical staff member to monitor changes relevant to the clinical side of your business.

Secondly, ensure that you are subscribed to receive the right communications and that they are going to the right person at your practice.
